- (H) Any act or abuse by spoken words , email, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- (I) Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student.

Women Empowerment Cell 2021-22

The Women Empowerment Cell of the college strives to achieve its objectives and aims at social upliftment of the girl students. The Cell facilitates empowerment through workshop, training programme, guest lectures and other meaningful activities to educate and sensitize the girl students.

In the beginning of the year Cell organized an awareness programme titled "Red Revolution" in coordination with Rotary Club of Surat Roundtown. The Resource person Dr. Amisha Mehta guided the students on the topic "Unfolding myths of menstruation". The programme was an attempt to bring a revolutionary change in the way menstruation is dealt with in Indian homes.

Training programmes namely Beauty Care, Chocolate Making, Self Defence and Digital e-learning were arranged. In one week, workshop on Beauty Care and Two Days workshop on Chocolate making, students learned bridal make up, hair styling and hair cutting etc. They also learned to make various types of chocolates. Self defence training was also given to the girl students by Nalini Rana our alumna, as such training prepares them mentally and physically to defend themselves in dangerous and unforeseen circumstances. We also arranged Basic Computer Training Programme under *Aazadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav*. The workshop gave basic knowledge of computer viz. MS Word, MS Excel and PPT and also updated them on useful Apps and digital marketing.

To fulfil the objective of making girl students aware of health and hygiene we arranged Talk Show with leading gynaecologist Dr. Sonia Chandanani on "Nutrition and Personal Hygiene". The students actively participated and clarified their doubts.

In the month of December Cell organised Orientation Programme for First year girl students. The members apprised them about the objectives of the Cell, need of the WEC and various activities of the Cell.

A Yog session was organised on the eve of International Women's Day. Teaching and nonteaching staff participated in the programme. The trainer Khadija Godil who is also the student of B. Com Honors. The session began with Pranayams and Mudras and ended with meditation.
