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Annual Report 2022-23

Empowerment of students for their all round development through education is the motto of Sir K.P. College of Commerce. With a supportive Management, willing contribution of the administrative staff, a galaxy of competent, talented and dedicated faculty and enthusiastic participation of students in college activities, the college has excelled in every field. Our achievements speak for themselves.

Our results are always higher than University results. This year again an M.Com student cleared the UGC NET exam and was awarded JRF. Also 7 M.Com students cleared the GSET exam in Commerce. Research activities are constantly pursued by the faculties. The College has 21 faculty having Ph.D degree and 11 faculties have M.Phil degree. Two scholars were awarded Ph.D degree under the guidance of our faculty. Two more faculties were appointed as Ph. D guides. Faculties have published 10 research papers and 2 books and have attended 40 workshops/FDP/Seminars/Conferences during the year. Activities such as research orientation program, seminar on preparation of research proposal, SPSS training and 6 day workshop on UGC NET /SLET preparation were conducted for our P.G. students. 70 students have completed Tally accounting course. 111 students have completed 100 hours training under finishing school programme. Remedial classes and scope/dell classes were conducted. 15 Students were enrolled for the training. We have purchased language lab software too. One Day Orientation Workshop on Written and Spoken Communication Skills was conducted in July 2022 by the English Department of the College. The workshop imparted in-depth knowledge of the written and spoken communication skill curriculum and its practical implications in the classroom. Educational trips summer training and Internship were also organised.

Co-curricular and extra curricular activities organized by the college facilitate the process of creative and critical thinking. Under the Cultural Committee, various activities such as Talent Hunt, Inter Class Poetry Recitation Competition, State level Inter Collegiate Poetry Competition and workshop on Dramatics were organised. Students participated in the Youth festival organised by V.N.S.G.University and our student Ishant Kakadiya bagged the 1st prize in Instrument Music and Nivedi Dayani 3rd prize in Vocal Music. The Women Empowerment Cell has ensured physical, mental, social and emotional well-being of girl students through various activities



such as 6 day workshops on beauty care and chocolate making, awareness programs on cyber crime, breast feeding, breast cancer and red revolution.

Activities such as NSS and NCC inculcate not only the love for social service , discipline, pride of Indian culture and traditions but also make them good human beings and confident leaders. NCC 5th and 6th Gujarat battalion conducted 134 parades, 23 camps, and various activities such as swatchata Abhiyan, blood donation camp, Nasha Mukth Bharat Abhiyan, Har Ghar Tiranga, Yoga Day, celebration of Independence Day and Republic Day, various training such as Drill, Map Reading, Firing , Field Craft, Battle Craft and weapon training were organised. Many awards were won by our outstanding cadets. NSS Committee conducted activities such as tree plantation, yoga day, voter ID registration, cleanliness drive at Dumas beach, Tiranga Yatra Rally, Blood donation camps, seminar on climate change, waste management. 7 day NSS camp was organized at Balkas Gam where our students have learnt community living and service. The College is now a Recognized Social Entrepreneurship , Swachhta and Rural Engagement Cell Institution by Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education, Government of India.

Planning Forum Committee conducted 6 days training workshop for girls on 'Co-operation', 5 day training program on Financial Education for Investors and Lecture on Strategic and Central Budget 2023-24 were organized. Under Suryakant Shah Nivrutti Fund, essay competition on current topics and seminar on 'Superstitions and Society was organised. In order to develop inter personal and public speaking skills, Debate and Elocution Committee organised Quiz competition, Elocution competition, Slogan writing competition, Innovative Idea for combating climate change competition, essay writing competition, power point presentation competition, Ad competition and Debate competition. Guest lectures on Commodity Derivatives was also organised.

Career Counselling Committee conducted various seminars on different career opportunities such as bank jobs, government competitive exams, awareness on government scholarships, CAT preparation for MBA and one week workshop on UGC NET/GSET Exam preparation. Free classes for competitive exam preparations are also conducted. Job fairs have been organised often and Students have been placed.

Pushpanjali Committee conducted Drawing competition, Aarti and Diya competition, Thali making competition, floral and traditional Mehdi competition, hairstyle hair - do competition, jewellery making competition, fabric painting competition, rangoli competition, toran making competition, and bouquet making competition. All the articles made by the students were displayed under 'Hunnar Haat' and were sold to students of the college.

THE Library has a rich collection of 71,469 books and it includes a special collection of competitive exam books, sports books and e books too. The library offers reprography and Internet facility, cubicle facility for reading to students, Mahatma Gandhi Aid book bank, Student Aid book bank, Acharya Kunjvihar Mehta Aid book



bank, Inter library loan facility, Online Public Access Catalogue and Online Access under N List Program of Inffibnet.

The College has a distinguished reputation in the field of sports too. Students have bagged prizes at International, National and State level games. The college has organized inter collegiate games such as Wrestling(Women) and Wrestling (Men), Handball (Women) and (Men), Badminton (Men) on behalf of V.N.S.G.U, Badminton(Men) and (Women) for Sarvajanic Cup. Randeria Nitai participated at Asia Triathlon Cup and South Asian Championship at Nepal. Raikvar Neelam won the Gold Medal in National Wrestling (Grappling) Championship – 2022 held at Gonda (UP), Rana Parth won the Gold Medal (66 kg, Dead Lift)at All India Powerlifting Championship held at Indira Gandhi Stadium, Delhi, Rana Parth won Silver Medal (66 kg, Power Lifting) atAll India Powerlifting Championship held at Indira Gandhi Stadium, Delhi , Sharma Sachin won Silver Medal All India Inter University Cycling (Road) Championship – 2023 held at MGM, University, Aurangabad, Sarang Harshal bagged the2nd Position in All India Sea Swimming Competition held at Porbandar, Raikvar Neelam won Bronze Medal 3rd phase of Khelo India senior national Wrestling Ranking Tournament at Rohtak (Haryana), Raikvar Monu won Bronze Medal National Wrestling (Grappling) Championship – 2022 held at Gonda (UP), Sarang Harsh won Bronze Medal (4x50 m Freestyle) at 75th Senior National Aquatic Championship - 2022 held at Guwahati, Sharma Sachin won the Team 3rd place at All India Inter University Cycling (Road) Championship – 2023 held at MGM, University, Aurangabad. Also 12 students have participated at the National Level in games such as Triathlon, Netball, Cricket, Artistic Gymnastics, Swimming, Cycling, Wrestling and Carrom. 27 students were selected as University players in different games. Gold and Silver medals were won at State and Inter Collegiate Level Championship. We were champions in swimming, yoga, rifle shooting and kabaddi at Inter Collegiate games.

The College alumni has played an active role too. They have helped the non teaching adhoc staff by giving them a mediclaim insurance of Rs. 300000 and a cash amount of Rs. 4000 each. Also Rs. 21000 was given by the Alumni Association to the adhoc staff who retired in June 2023. Scholarships worth Rs. 4,03,800 to the students belonging to the open category were also given by the College and Rs. 25000 were given as medical aid to a sports student who underwent a knee operation.
