
ANALYSIS ON STUDENTS FEEDBACK







Communication skills (Articulations and comprehensibility) 220 responses




As per above chart-1.6, the results show that majority students 99.1% provided very good rating regarding the teacher's communication skills. It means teachers possess strong communication skill.



Ability to design assignments/examination to test understanding of the course.




